


FOUNDATIONAL THERAPY FOR DRY EYE

DRY EYE **DISEASE** AND MEIBOMIAN GLAND **DYSFUNCTION**

The Tear Film is a very thin film across the eye surface that is made up of 3 layers: oil, water,

The Meibomian Glands produce the oily layer of the tear film. In Dry Eye Disease, the oils from these glands do not flow freely, which may cause oil on the surface of the eye allows tears to evaporate quickly, resulting in an uncomfortable, dry, and gritty sensation.
