

**DRY EYE DISEASE**

The **Tear Film** is a very thin film across the eye surface that is made up of **3 layers: oil, water, and mucus.**

The **Meibomian Glands** produce the oily layer of the tear film. In Dry Eye Disease, the oils from these glands do not flow freely, which may cause the gland openings to become plugged. Reduced oil on the surface of the eye allows tears to evaporate quickly, resulting in an uncomfortable, dry, and gritty sensation.
